## Q -01 How does Doctor's Choice work?

## Q -03 Are the advocates licensed?

## Q -06 How does your consultation work?

At the time of the consultation, your advocate calls you directly or meets you on Zoom for 30–45 minutes. Afterward, you'll receive a written summary plus a plan recommendation based on your healthcare needs and situation.
